Theme: Heritage Designs. 2017: DESIGN Scout Trucks – Begin your design work Each Scout purchases an 18 Wheeler Scout Truck kit which consists of: Blocks of wood and hardboard panels for trailer 18 plastic wheels Ten finishing nails (axles) 1 Trailer Pin, dowel for fuel tanks and stacks and front bumper A rules / instructions sheet Scouts are encouraged to create and build their Trucks using the above materials.	18 Wheeler Scout Truck Information All scout Trucks must pass the following inspection to qualify for the race: 1. Overall width, including wheels, shall not exceed 8.5 cm/80 mm (3-1/4 inches) 2. Length shall not exceed 44.5 cm/420 mm (16-1/2 inches) 3. Weight shall not exceed 900.0 g (31.745 ounces) 4. The minimum distance between the wheels is 44.5 mm (1¾ inches) 5. Clearance between the chassis and the track should be 0.95 cm (3/8ths of an inch)	6. Axles, wheels, and body shall be from the materials provided in the kit 7. Wheel bearings, washers, and bushings are not permitted 8. No lubricating oil may be used. Axles may, however, be lubricated with powdered graphite 9. The Trucks shall not ride on any kind of spring 10. The Trucks must be free-wheeling, with no starting devices No loose materials of any kind are allowed. All weights must be fixed in position NEW: The weight for the Scout Truck is to be added between the front and rear axle Maximum total weight allowance is 800 gm.




